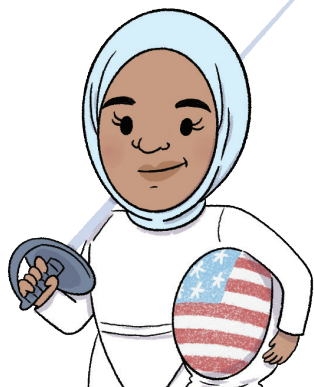

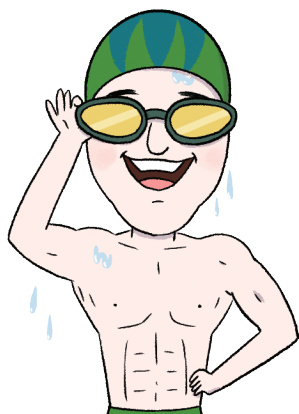
## ★ SIMONE BILES ★

- HOLDS EIGHT OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALS
